New Forest LEADER will use its best endeavours to safeguard the privacy of its website visitors. This policy explains the website data processing practices of New Forest LEADER.

What information do we collect?

In some areas, we may ask you to register your name and email address. We will also collect information from you if you complete any other forms on our site or if you contact us with comments or specific requests.

What do we use personal information for?

Information to improve our site
